- Tradition 4: "Each group should be autonomous except in matters affecting other groups or A.A. as a whole."
- Long Form: "With respect to its own affairs, each A.A. group should be responsible to no other authority than its own conscience. But when its plans concern the welfare of neighboring groups also, those groups ought to be consulted. And no group, regional committee, or individual should ever take any action that might greatly affect A.A. as a whole without conferring with the Trustees of the General Service Board. On such issues our common welfare is paramount."

• <u>Concept 4 Workshop Recap</u>: Chris

- Concept 4: "Throughout our Conference structure, we ought to maintain at all responsible levels a traditional "Right of Participation," taking care that each classification or group of our world servants shall be allowed a voting representation in reasonable proportion to the responsibility that each must discharge."
- Synopsis: "The principle of 'Right of Participation' is built into the General Service Conference through the Conference Charter. Voting members include not only delegates, but also the trustees, and the directors and staff members of A.A. World Services (i.e., G.S.O.) and the AA Grapevine. In the same way, the boards of these two operating entities include as voting members not only trustees, but also nontrustee directors and paid administrators and staff members. The chairperson of the General Service Board appoints nontrustee members to the standing committees in order to have the advantage of their expertise, and staff members serve as committee secretaries. "There are no 'superiors,' no 'inferiors,' and no 'advisers.'"

Her opinion is that it should be postponed because she's not getting the same amount of feedback that she usually does; she's worried many voices will be unheard during this time
- Area 09 Delegate, Ed L.
 - Four of the seven board members are present on our meeting tonight
 - Has been attending Zoom meetings with other delegates
 - 93 agenda items, 56 of which require feedback
 - He has heard other people opine that Pre-Conference should be postponed, but doesn't believe it will be because there are 135 participants that have been preparing for months, including scheduling time off from work
 - Reports are published in July
 - New York recently polled to see how many are comfortable continuing with Pre-Conference virtually (Zoom)
 - Round tables virtually will be a unique challenge
 - Even though participation and feedback levels are much lower than usual, all we can do is continue to make the information and tools available and carry on with business as usual
