To quote from the AA Service Manual (page S-19), "We need it to ensure that changes within AA come only as a response to the needs and wants of all AA, and not of any few. We need it to ensure that the doors of the halls of AA never have locks on them, so that all people for all time who have an alcoholic problem may enter these halls unasked and feel welcome. We need it to ensure that Alcoholics Anonymous never asks of anyone who needs us what his or her race is. what his or her creed it, what his or her social position is." Don't let contempt prior to investigation keep you from serving.
