

MSCA09 Young Person's Standing Committee

Guidelines

1. Statement of Purpose:

The purpose of a YPAA Standing Committee is to connect individual YPAA coordinate committees within our Area, to participate in the Conference structure through our Area Service Committee meetings, and to teach others interested about YPAA and General Service opportunities. We bring YPAA into the fold of the General Service “scene” in the Mid Southern California Area 09 and serve as a connection between all YPAA coordinate committees within Area 09.

2. Duties and Responsibilities:

- I. Teach the history of YPAA.
- II. Explain what individual YPAA committees consist of and their functions.
- III. Spread knowledge of YPAA related literature.
- IV. Arrange Q & A and round table discussions of topics, such as common misconceptions, problems that may arise within a YPAA committee, and how to help a committee thrive.
- V. Organize YPAA committee workshops to share experience, strength and hope for the future of YPAA.
- VI. Encourage YPAA participation in General Service in the Mid Southern California Area through outreach, workshops, and a monthly committee meeting.

3. Committee Membership and Voting:

Membership shall consist of an English-speaking Chair, a Spanish-speaking Chair, an English-speaking Alt-Chair, and Spanish-speaking Alt-Chair.

YPAA committee members within Area 09 and all members of Area 09 interested in the activities of the committee.

All members who have attended one previous YPAA standing committee meeting are full voting members.

4. Committee Meetings:

The Young Person's Standing Committee will normally meet at the allotted committee time at ASCs and Assemblies and additionally as needed and as agreed upon by its members.
